Good morning

I received a note from Fr. Sauve, the designated executive director of the AJCU, telling that Fr. James Carter (former president of Loyola University New Orleans), the acting executive director, is planning to attend our meeting at Seattle (or at least stop by).

Fr. Sauve has asked Fr. Carter to talk with us about the AJCUNet project and to ask us what recommendations we could offer to the AJCU to help both the national office and the AJCU institutions derive more benefits from the AJCUNet project.

Please remember that the project breaks down into two components: the AJCU web server and the AJCUNet communications client-server. The AJCUNet client-server was what was announced last August and which some of installed at some of our sites.
