Dear Colleague:

I would like to take this opportunity to formally invite you to the **Eleventh Annual Conference for Information Technology Management** to be held at Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska on April 27-30, 1997. Enclosed you will find a conference registration form and other materials related to our conference.

I am happy to note that members of AUSJAL are invited to this regular conference of the AJCU-CITM as full participants. We hope that a good many will join us.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

A block of rooms has been reserved at the Old Market Embassy Suites hotel in Omaha. You must make your reservations directly with the hotel by calling 1-800-EMBASSY (362-2779). Be sure to indicate that you are with the Creighton/AJCU Conference to get the special daily rate of \$112 plus taxes (total - \$124.xx). All rooms are the same except that you have a choice of King or Double Double.

Members of AUSJAL can receive hotel reservation assistance from the Creighton staff by e-Mailing either name on the registration form or agenda survey form.

TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation to and from Eppley Airport is available by cab or limousine service. The hotel operates a limo service. The airport terminal is less than four miles from the hotel, so cab fares are less than \$ 8.00. If you drive in to Omaha, the hotel has its own parking garage.

REGISTRATION:

The registration fee for this year's conference is \$175.00, (down from last year's \$200.00). This fee includes all breakfast, noon and evening meals on regular conference days (April 28, 29, 30). It also includes a welcoming event to be held at the hotel on Sunday, April 27.

CONFERENCE AGENDA:

The Conference will begin on Monday, April 28th, with an on-campus breakfast at 8:00 and adjourn on Wednesday at 1:00pm. A welcoming event will be held Sunday evening in the hotel starting at 6:00pm.

The opening session will be an address by the Creighton University President, Rev. Michael G. Morrison, S.J.. Several employees of the University will be attending our sessions as guests and resource personnel.

We will have our traditional "Birds of a Feather" session, limiting it to one report per institution. Plan for your report for no longer than five minutes.

We will be taking our traditional campus tour of the host institution as well.

BUSINESS MEETINGS:

Our annual Business Meeting will be held the first day, immediately after lunch. Arrangements have been made for AUSJAL to have separate meeting space should they want to meet separately. The Secretary will have a full agenda of items for discussion at this meeting.

CONFERENCE DINNER:

The Conference Dinner will be held on the Creighton University campus at the new Lied Center for Arts Education. After the dinner, which will be centered on special Omaha Steaks, we will have a planned presentation given by the Creighton faculty who have been identified as technology "fellows" during the past two years.

WEEKEND EVENTS:

Expecting that many of you will be coming to Omaha on Saturday to take advantage of reduced airfare rates, we have several events planned. First, there will be a golf outing for those who wish to play. Several Creighton administrators are committed to being your partners. Second, Omaha is famous for its Henry Doorly Zoo, which is less than 30 blocks from the hotel, right on the same street. The Zoo, with its Aquarium, I-Max Theater and Rain Forest, is a major midwest attraction. And just across the Missouri river in Iowa, and only a cab ride away, are three Casinos. Though we'd hate to see you leave your money in Iowa, they do provide a good time and good food.
