Reminder: Daylight Savings Time begins at 2AM on Sunday. Clocks move forward one hour. The times above are Eastern Daylight Time.

Monday, April 8

7:30 a.m. Conference shuttle bus service begins to the Georgetown campus, and it continues until 11 a.m. Service will be supplemented by GUTS parking shuttle service. Conference buses will leave you at the main University gates at 37th and O Streets. Conference buses should leave approx. at 7:30, 8:00, and 8:30 prior to the opening session, and service is included in the Conference fee. Turn the page for directions to Copley Hall from the Main Gate.

As an alternative, the GU parking shuttle leaves the Key Bridge Marriott every 15 minutes. It arrives on campus at the Leavey Center transportation area on campus near Henle Student Village. If you are facing Henle Village, take the long sidewalk to the right and proceed to "Red Square" (approximately three minutes). Copley Hall is at the far end of the red-brick square. Use the first door (on the right, with 10 or so steps) to enter Copley Hall. Copley Formal Lounge is immediately beyond the entrance. During Rush Hour, it will take approximately 15-20 minutes to get to campus. GUTS parking shuttle buses depart every 15 minutes between 5AM and 9:15AM only. The one way fare is \$1.00 for parking shuttle buses so it's to your advantage to take the conference shuttle.

If it's a nice day, you may want to walk to campus. To do so, leave the Key Bridge Marriott, walk across the Potomac River using the Francis Scott Key Bridge. At the end of the bridge, cross M Street, walk up the Hill to O Street, N.W. and make a left. Proceed to the University's Main Gate at 37th & O Street, N.W.

Copley Hall is the building to the immediate right of Healy Hall (the national historical landmark building with clock tower). Proceed to the far right (north) of the Copley Hall using the right diagonal walkway (from the Main Gate). At the far north end, walk to your left and use the far door with the metal steps to enter Copley Formal Lounge.
